## **VEGETABLES 2010**

### **ASPARAGUS – 2 YEAR ROOTS** (begin cutting at 3 years old)

**Jersey Knight:** plant in sun, in well drained location. Reliable, rust resistant & productive. Tightly budded stalks hold at peak quality and flavor over long cutting period

### **BROCCOLI**

**PAKMAN:** 50 day. AAS Large 6-7” heads (1 lb.) with side shoots for further harvesting. Excellent quality and uniformity with disease tolerance.

### **BRUSSEL SPROUTS**

**JADE E. CROSS:** large sprouts, closely set and easy to remove. Excellent quality

### **CABBAGE**

**EARLY FLAT DUTCH:** 85 day. Midseason ball-shaped heads up to 9” in diameter.

**LATE FLAT DUTCH:** 100 day. Large 6 lb. flat topped head good for kraut and slaw

**RUBY PERFECTION:** 80 day. 3-4 lb. Deep red round head

### **CANTALOUPE**

**AMBROSIA:** 86 day. 4 lb. Round fruits with peach-colored flesh, heavy nets and light sutures. Terrific sweet flavor.

**BURPEE HYBRID:** 82 day 4 lb. Strong netting pattern and ribs. Dark orange flesh is firm and juicy. Great in Northern states.

### **CAULIFLOWER**

**SELF-BLANCHE:** 68 day. Wrapper leaves curl over the heads to blanch white.

### **CELERY**

**GIANT PASCAL:** 90 day. Tender, 30” crisp stalks of high quality.

### **CUCUMBER**

**BURPLESS #26:** 62 day. 10”x2” straight, smooth, dark green slicer. Burpless  
Strong tolerance to Mosaic Virus.

**SWEET SLICE:** 63 day. Gourmet 10-12” long tapered dark green fruits. Few seeds  
with a sweet bitterfree skin. Great slicer and burpless. Does NOT need peeling.

**BURPLESS BUSH:** 55 day. 10-12” straight nearly seedless. Bush habit. Burpless

**STRAIGHT EIGHT:** 58 day. 8” fruits with excellent flavor. A long time favorite

**BUSH PICKLE:** 54 day. Ideal pickling 4-5” fruit. Compact plant

**MARKETMORE :** Excellent disease resistance

### **EGGPLANT**

**DUSKY:** 63 day. Early, high yielding, good Northern variety

**GOURDS:** assorted novelty varieties

## **KOHLRABI**

GRAND DUKE: 45 day. AAS Winner. Bulb-like stems have mild flavor cooked or raw.

## **ONION**

SETS: yellow sweet Spanish, white sweet Spanish, Candy

PLANTS: Bunching onions

## **PARSLEY**

ITALIAN (flat leaf): Better culinary flavor than curly

CURLY: used mainly for garnishing

## **PEPPER – SWEET**

BIG BERTHA: 72 day. 7"x4" very large, crisp fruit. Great for stuffing.

CALIFORNIA WONDER: 75 day. Large 4"x4" green fruit. High yields.

GOLDEN SUMMER – Yellow block 4"x4" very prolific

RED BEAUTY-68 day. Gourmet red with extra thick walls with good shelf life and excellent sweet flavor. Resistant to T.M.V. High yielding 4x4 red fruit.

SWEET BANANA: 70 day. 1 1/2"x5 1/2" yellow tapered fruit with thin walls.

MANDARINE – orange

## **PEPPER – HOT**

RED CHILI: 75 day. 2"x 4" medium-hot fruits tasty canned, dried, fried or pickled.

GARDEN SALSA: 73 day. Mildly hot with lots of flavor. Great for salsa making.

HUNGARIAN WAX:(hot banana) 70 day. Yellow 2x8" tapered spicy, fairly hot banana-shaped fruit.

LONG RED CAYENNE: 70 day. Extremely productive, slim "cayenne type". Very hot.

JALAPENO: lots of heat

TAM JALAPENO: flavor of a jalapeno without all the heat

LONG RED CAYENNE: **very hot!**

## **POTATO**

Red varieties: RED PONTIAC, RED CHIEFTAN

White varieties: KENNEBEC, KATAHDIN, YUKON GOLD, IRISH COBBLER

## **PUMPKIN**

JACK-BE-LITTLE: small decorative 4" pumpkins with flattened tops.

HOWDEN: Medium size Jack-o-lantern type 15-20 lb average.

BIG MAX: Large 100-200 lb. pumpkins

## **SQUASH**

CROOKNECK: 52 day. 5 1/2" bright yellow crookneck. Compact bush. Summer squash

STRAIGHT NECK: bright yellow summer squash with straight neck

TABLE ACE (acorn): 70 day. 5"x6" dark black/green acorn shaped fruit. Semi-bush

Almost no fibers or stringiness Winter squash

BUTTERNUT: 82 day. 10"x12" tan fruit. Early & high yielding winter squash

## **STRAWBERRIES**

OSARK BEAUTY-**June bearing**. Great for preserves and fresh eating. Large fruits.

FORT LARAMIE-hardest **everbearer** you can grow with fair amount of runners and huge crops of honey-sweet flavored berries. Everbearers produce fruit during the regular season, with a second crop later

## **SWISS CHARD**

BRIGHT LIGHTS: 60 day. Mild flavor, multi-colored stems orange, red, pink, yellow

## **TOMATO**

### **YELLOW**

LEMON BOY – low acid, bright yellow

JUBILEE GOLDEN – low acid, golden-orange color

### **PINK**

PINK GIRL: 65 day. 5-7 oz. Early with excellent flavor. Dwarf indeterminate

### **PATIO**

BUSH GOLIATH: short 24” plant but bears many medium sized red round fruits

### **PASTE (meaty)**

ROMA (plum): 75 day. The most well-known paste-type tomato perfect for sauces, Pastes and catsup. Pear-shape fruits are meaty, with very few seeds.

VIVA ITALIA: great paste variety

QUIMBAYA: similar to roma but longer. Great flavor and meaty

### **CHERRY**

SMALL FRY: 65 day. AAS WINNER. Bite size 1 oz. cherry (larger than supersweet 100). Bush plant

SUPERSWEET 100: 65 day. Plants produce long strands of 100 or more super-sweet Flavored cherry tomatoes that grow in clusters like grapes. Indeterminate.

GRAPETTE: medium sized oval/grape shape fruits with great flavor & high yields.

### **EARLY VARIETIES**

EARLY GIRL: 57 day. High yields of 4-6 oz. Slicing tomatoes. Indeterminate

### **LARGE SIZE**

ACE 55: low acid red variety

BEEFMASTER: 80 day. Beefsteak type. Solid, meaty fruits up to 2 lb. Indeterminate

BETTER BOY: 75 day. 8 oz. Known for consistency & performance. Indeterminate

BURPEE BIG BOY: 78 day. 1 lb. fruit with smooth crack-free skin. Superb flavor

CELEBRITY:72 day. 8 oz. Fruit AAS winner with excellent flavor

MARGLOBE: 75 day. Large, red, globe-shaped fruits with thick walls. **\*canning**

RUTGERS: 75 day. All-purpose variety ideal for canning. 7 oz. Smooth, firm fruit.

Open pollinated variety. Indeterminate

## **Tomato - continued**

### **HEIRLOOM TOMATO**

BRANDYWINE: 90-100 day. This heirloom Amish variety, dating back to 1885, features one of the finest flavored large tomatoes ever offered. Plants look like potato vines with good yields of extra-large, firm, clear-skinned, light rosy pink fruits, up to 1-1/2 lbs. Indeterminate.

HILLBILLY: 85 day. Ancient heirloom that hails from the hills of West Virginia.  
1 to 2 lbs. Orange-yellow color streaked and mottled with shades of red and pink.  
Indeterminate

### **STUFFING TYPE**

STRIPED RED CAVERN: blocky walled tomato with hollow inside

### **WATERMELON**

CRIMSON SWEET-88 day. 25lb dark red, firm very sweet flesh. Resistant to wilts.  
SUGAR BABY-75 day. Small 8lb fruits, small seeds, very productive. Sweet flavor

### **ZUCCHINI**

BLACK BEAUTY (green): 47 day. 6-8" blackish/green smooth, cylindrical fruit.  
GOLD RUSH (yellow): 52 day. 7"-8" golden yellow zucchini

## **SMALL FRUITS**

Blackberries - thornless
